

MESSAGE FROM PASTOR STEVE

And Jesus increased in wisdom and in years, and in divine and human favor. Luke 2:52

This is all we know of Jesus childhood (besides getting left behind at the temple when he was 12) from his infancy to the beginning of his public ministry when he was about 30 years old.

Yet there is a lot in that verse from Luke. Increasing in wisdom is important as children grow into adults. Wisdom can't be bought. Wisdom is knowing what is important, and what is not.

Jesus increased in years and in divine and human favor. Two areas where Jesus "increased" was in his relationship with God his Father and in his relationship with people. Any wise person will have good relationships with God and with people.

What can we do as parents and youth to increase in wisdom, in years, and in favor with God and man? Let me offer a few basic but important commitments.

To grow in wisdom, talk as a family about what matters and what doesn't. If you are watching TV together, discuss what you are seeing. If you see a commercial that is full of lies, talk about it. If you haven't already, make family devotions a part of your family time together. Just a few minutes a day can make a big difference over the years in the direction we go in our lives.

To grow in favor with God make worship a priority as a family. Take time to thank God publicly, to listen to His Word, to learn hymns and songs that have guided God's people throughout the centuries. Be strengthened in your faith as you receive communion. Be committed to our congregation's programs of Sunday school, confirmation, senior high youth group or an adult Bible study.

Encourage youth to attend Bible Camps and mission trips.

We need each other's support and encouragement along life's journey. Come to be strengthened in your faith and to help strengthen others' faith. As you make good choices on faith formation habits you will be much more likely to grow in divine and human favor.

ADULT AND FAMILY BORDER TRIPS IN 2020

Border trips to the US/Mexico border in south Texas are available with the company Border Perspective. They offer 2 types of trips. The Service Learning Trips are for adults or families, are 6 days long, and are designed to be immersive, educational and will intentionally place you in the lives of immigrant leaders serving families on the U.S. & Mexico border. You will volunteer at a local shelter and serve alongside immigrant pastors and their congregations. This trip costs \$425/person and does NOT include transportation to get there. The South Texas Border Journey trips are for adults only, are for 4 days, and are intended to be educational and immersive. It will intentionally place you in the lives of immigrant leaders and you will hear and learn more about the immigrant issues. Trip cost is \$750/person and includes local transportation but neither trip includes transportation to get to Harlingen, TX. QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DONATIONS

After age 70 1/2 and older, individuals may distribute up to \$100,000 tax-free each year from their IRAs to certain charitable organizations without including the amount of the charitable distribution in gross income when filling tax returns.

An added benefit is this method of giving also reduces gross income for the calculation determining the amount of Social Security benefits that may be taxable.

YTD 2019 we have collected over \$23,000 in QCD donations. CLC members donate over \$67,000 annually through electronic giving.
